Category 1	
Price £502 per year or £42 per month	
Peak	For members that want a membership with access to the club at any time and are not restricted to coached sessions.

Price £396 per year or £33 per month		
Off-Peak	No access after 4pm on a weekday or before 12 noon on a weekend,	
	Members must be deemed competent to row unsupervised by a	
	coach, vice-captain or captain to be able to take boats out during off-	
	peak times.	
Coach with rowing	Fulfils all the requirements for a coach's membership and is actively	
	coaching a set group/squad at the club in peak times, that also wants	
	to row in peak times. This membership is at the discretion of the	
	Chairman and Captain of Boats.	
Land Only	No use of on water equipment, can use the indoor facilities at peak	
	times. Only available to people that do not require a coach present	
	when training.	
Student/Apprentice	Member must be in full time further education. Proof may be	
	requested by the club upon completion of membership.	
Adult Distant	Same access as a Peak Membership but the Members Permanent	
	home must lie 75 miles or more from Stratford Upon Avon BC.	
Junior 14+	Membership for older juniors who will receive pre-arranged, coached	
	sessions per week within organised groups and supervised by a	
	qualified coach.	
Novice	A member that is in their first year of rowing and access is restricted to	
	supervised sessions until signed off by a coach, vice-captain or club	
	captain.

Price £270 per year (monthly n/a)	
Junior 13	Membership for those within this year group who will receive pre- arranged, coached sessions, within organised groups and supervised by a qualified coach.
Adaptive **	Only available to rowers including those under the age of 18, who have been assessed within adaptive rowing categories by an adaptive coach/assessor.
Distant Junior	This membership is for juniors who are living far enough away from Stratford-upon-Avon, that rowing regularly is not feasible Available at Junior Co-ordinator's discretion only.

Notes and Exceptions

Monthly payments are allowed where stated and can be stopped during the course of the membership year, if you wish to terminate your membership. If you wish to restart your membership during the same membership year then a £30 admin fee is payable.

An admin fee of £30 is also payable for late membership renewal. This is applied if you have been a member in the previous year and you renew your membership outside of the membership renewal window after the first monthly payment would have been paid. Exceptions to this can be made at the discretion of the executive.

Students just visiting for the summer and have not previously been full members of the club will pay the monthly fee in line with the yearly peak membership (£42) for each month that they row at the club.
